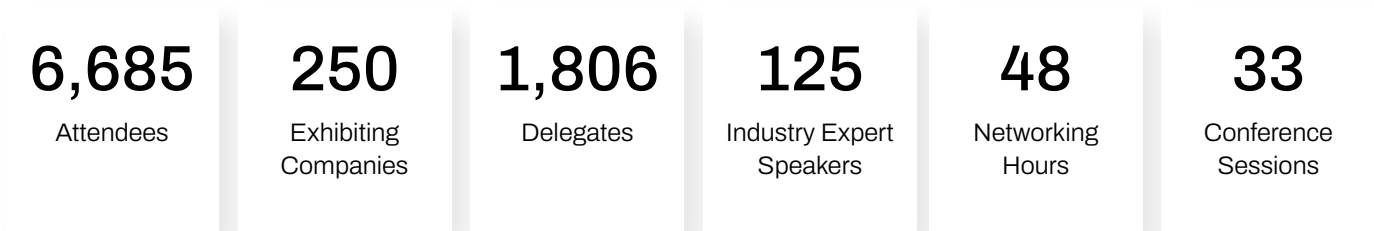
## Accelerating Global Energy Progress Through Investment, Partnerships & Innovation

## NIGERIAN CONTENT SEMINAR

30 JUNE 2025

The **Nigerian Content Seminar** explored critical themes around deepening local capacity, enabling sustainable investment, and aligning local content strategies with Nigeria's broader energy security goals. Key discussions included the role of technology as a national asset, the strategic value of cross-border infrastructure, and the evolving impact of funding mechanisms like the Nigerian Content Intervention Fund (NCIF).

Speaking at the seminar, **Engr. Felix Omatsola Ogbe, Executive Secretary, Nigerian Content Development & Monitoring Board (NCDMB)**, reinforced the relevance of this year's theme, "Achieving Energy Sufficiency Through Local Content Implementation", and highlighted the Board's commitment to timely approvals, improved compliance mechanisms, and alignment with the Presidential Directives on Ease of Doing Business.

He said, "Energy sufficiency is not just about access; it encompasses resilience, sustainability, and national sovereignty. These pillars depend on strong domestic capabilities. In this context, local content is not merely a policy; it is a strategic imperative that fosters an enabling environment for investments".

Stakeholders echoed support for the NOGICD Act and Presidential Executive Orders 001 and 005, while also calling for smarter regulation, improved access to finance, and strategic investment in technology and workforce development. Sessions underscored the need for energy infrastructure diversification, regional collaboration, and stronger alignment between education and industry to shape a future-ready energy sector.
