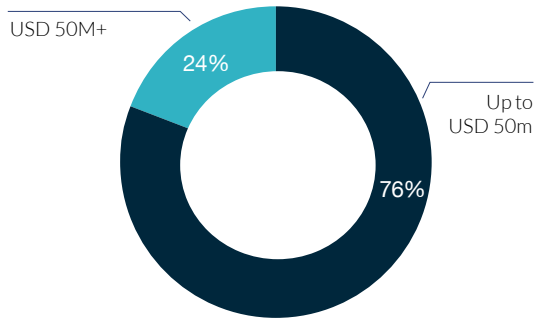

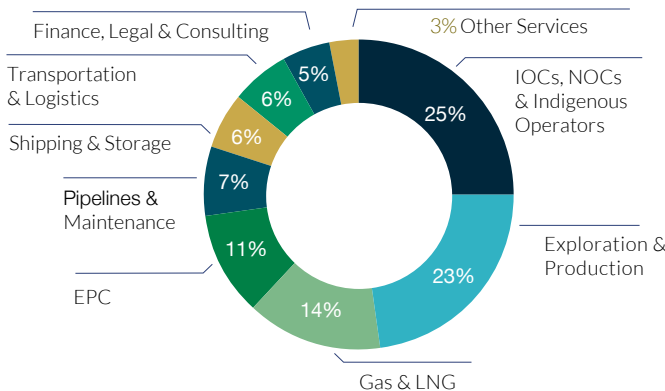
Attendee Breakdown by Level of Purchasing Responsibility



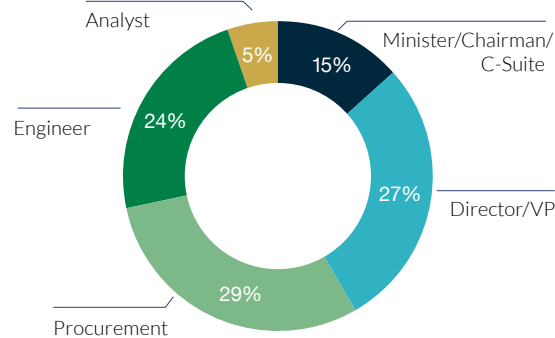
Attendee Breakdown by Yearly Purchasing Budget

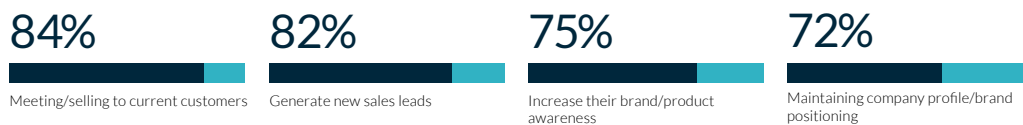

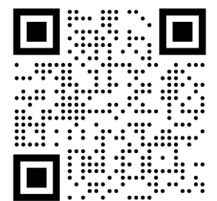

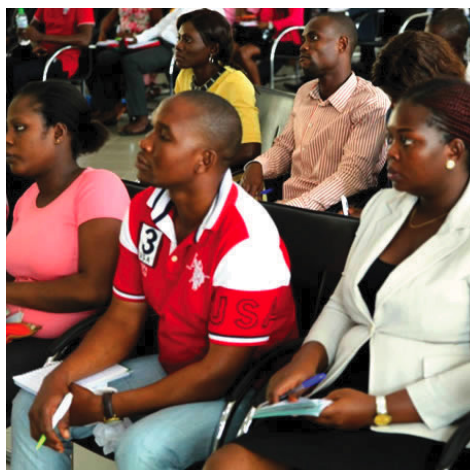
