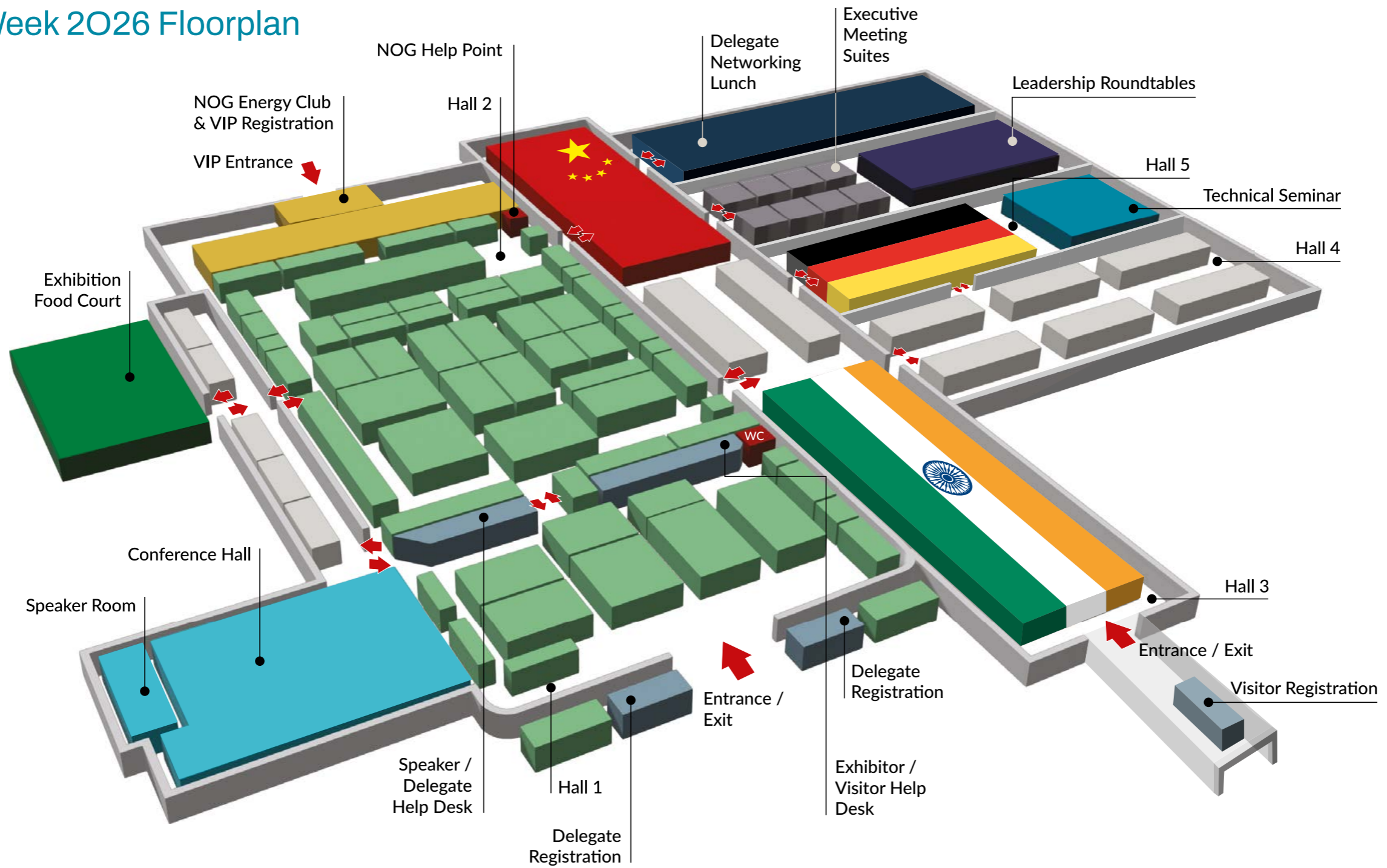

Plan Your Trip to Abuja

Airport Access

Most international and regional attendees arrive via Nnamdi Azikiwe International Airport (ABV). The airport is approximately 40 minutes from the Bola Ahmed Tinubu International Conference Centre. Airport taxis, ride-hailing services, and hotel-arranged transfers are widely available.

Ride-Hailing Services

Uber and Bolt operate extensively across Abuja and are the preferred mode of transport for many attendees. These services provide reliable, app-based travel between hotels, business districts, and the Bola Ahmed Tinubu International Conference Centre, with upfront pricing and cashless payment options.

Taxis & Hotel Shuttles

Licensed taxis are available at hotels, shopping centres, and the airport. Many hotels also offer private shuttle services to and from the Bola Ahmed Tinubu International Conference Centre, which is recommended for ease and convenience during peak event hours.

Car Hire & Private Drivers

For attendees seeking flexibility and comfort, car hire with a professional driver is a popular option. This is especially suitable for business travellers with multiple meetings across the city. Most major hotels and travel agencies can assist with bookings.

Public Transport

Abuja has city buses and a light rail system connecting the airport to the city, including Idu Station.

Local Travel

The Bola Ahmed Tinubu International Conference Centre is centrally located, close to key districts such as Central Business District, Maitama, and Wuse.
